

# Interested in becoming a Bail Justice?

Virtual Information Sessions (4 May – 11 May)

The Department of Justice and Community Safety is now recruiting new Bail Justice volunteers across Victoria. We're looking for Victorians who are eager to serve their community by taking on this important responsibility.

Bail Justices play a key role ensuring people across Victoria have access to justice services. Bail Justices conduct after-hours bail and remand hearings. When a person is held in police custody out of regular business hours, a Bail Justice will determine whether the alleged offender should be remanded or granted bail.

There is an expectation that all Bail Justices will respect, observe, and adhere to the highest levels of personal, social and community standards of integrity and professionalism to ensure that all Victorians are provided with an independent, fair, and impartial service.

This is a fantastic opportunity to be at the frontline of Victoria's justice system working after-hours and on weekends conducting bail hearings in person or in remote settings.

The Honorary Justice Services Support team will be holding virtual information sessions to provide more details about the role and give participants the opportunity to meet other Bail Justices and staff from the Honorary Justice Services Support team.

Please note that attendance at this session is mandatory to proceed to the next recruitment and application steps to become a Bail Justice.
