## Accessible Eye Care

Consultations are bulk billed to Medicare if you are:

- A Pensioner Concession or Health Care cardholder (or listed as a dependent)
- An Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person
- A refugee or asylum seeker

**Note:** There are a handful of services not covered by Medicare and these services will attract a modest fee.

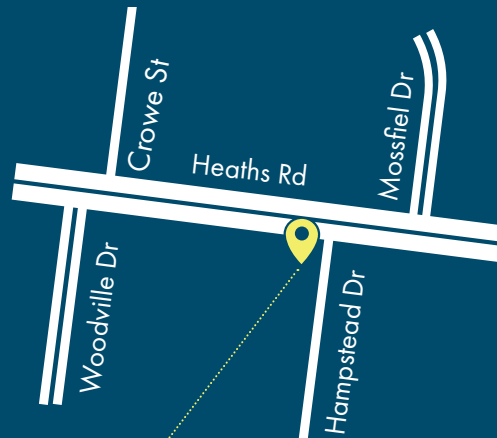
*Other patients will be required to pay a modest out-of-pocket fee.*
