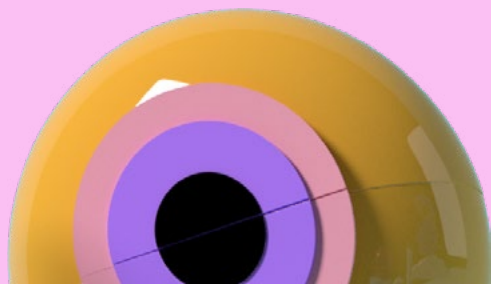


MUSICAL GARDEN BY JUNKLANDIA
